Summary: Five individuals traveled through the snow to Arlington Lower River Ponds. Cold (40's) partly cloudy, light breezes. Wound around Arlington, then up to Buckeye for lunch at Millstone Café.

BIRDS: Saw 42 species – highlights were American Pipits, lots of ducks on ponds – Ruddy, Green-winged Teal, Coots, Shovelers, Gadwall, cormorants - Burrowing Owls (hunched down cold), Great Blue Herons, Yellow-rumped warblers, hard-to-identify sparrows – we decided on Vesper and Savannah, Red-tailed Hawk, Peregrine Falcon.
