## ESTRELLA MT. REGIONAL PARK BIRDWALK 10 8 22

CONDITIONS: Ideal!!! At 7:00 AM the temperature was 73 degrees F with a breeze of 0-1 mph from the NE. Skies were partly cloudy dominated by altocumulus, alto stratus. At 8:45 AM the temperature was 82 degrees F with 85% sky cover, altocumulus, strato cumulus, cirrostratus and a breeze from the east at 1-2 mph.

COMMENTS: This event was enhanced by the presence of Caleb Strand, a bird guide based out of Tucson with Arizona Birding Tours. We documented 52 species, a record for this time of year at Estrella. Highlights were the vocalization from a Virginia Rail, a couple of sandpiper species, Red-naped Sapsuckers, plus three other woodpecker types, three warbler species, and a Crissal Thrasher to go along with the normally seen Curve-billed Thrasher and Northern Mockingbird. A Hammond's Flycatcher was seen as well (mesquite grove area).
