SAS Field Trips

Overview:

This will be about a three hour field trip checking out what is on the ponds at the Glendale Recharge Basins. This is a great place for waterfowl and shorebirds and those that prey on them. The nearby farm fields will add an additional variety so expect to see between 30-50 species. Hone up on your ducks and shorebirds before you go.

Things to Know/Bring:

· It may get windy so bring a jacket and water. This also is a good place for a spotting scope. Glendale Recharge Ponds are located approximately 13 miles North-West of Phoenix. Any car.

Directions: From Camelback, drive North on 107th Avenue to the end. Turn right on the dirt road (Bethany Home Rd.) and drive East 1/2 mile to the parking area. (The entrance at 107th and B.H. Rd. is now closed)

Difficulty: 1- about 2 miles of hiking on flat dirt roads.
