## WHITE TANK REG PARK BIRDWALK 3 25 23

CONDITIONS: Ideal. At 7:30 AM the skies were clear, temperature 48 degrees F and little to no breeze: at walk conclusion, 10:15 AM, still clear skies with some cumulus developing over the metro area east, slight breeze from the SW at 1-3 mph.

ROUTE: Observations were made first at the Nature Center, then the group caravanned to Area 4 and hiked the Black Rock Loop Trail Long Loop. Some sightings were made in the Area 4 parking area.

COMMENTS: The blessings from the frequent winter and early spring rains led to a bounty of wildflowers to behold. The colors were many as Brittlebush, Desert Marigolds, Stinknet and a few just opening Mexican Poppies flashed yellows and oranges for us to see and Coulter's Lupine, Globemallow, Owl Clover added the accents. Even a couple of cholla and hedgehog cactus were popping blooms. The

avian residents were dominated in song by Cactus Wrens. Ash-throated Flycatchers were about and several woodpecker types were hanging around the Saguaro tops. Canyon Wrens sent a chorus from the canyon and mountain sides and the White-crowned Sparrow were having a group sing to add to the desert music.
